One box will be saved for Fall mini-conference. Discussion about Lori leaving Grapevines at her workplace (Mercy Hospital) that were taken rather quickly. It was suggested that she clear it with Greg K. yet was encouraged to continue leaving Grapevines available at the Hospital.

**Corrections:** Tammy F – will now head up both women's and men's corrections. Karen H is helping Tammy. Now have Sgt Laror as liason for jail meetings. AA meetings are now back in the meeting room. 14 women currently rotating at women's meetings. Only 3 men rotating currently. Bill J has been told that the jail won't clear any more men to attend meetings as many men have already been cleared. Bill J and Joel B will speak with Marv W about getting additional men cleared.

**Treatment:** Joe H – Randy and Joe talked with Alcocare about their upcoming open house. Mercy wants AA back in the hospital but need to take it thru their own internal channels first. Caravel still needs to get back to Joe. Randy reported that Guy at Alcocare (next to Tallman House) will have the open house from 6-7pm on Monday

March 10<sup>th</sup>. Starting Monday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, participants at Alcocare can attend Monday night meeting ONLY IF they're given rides to meetings by AA members. Guy's policy is that males take males, and females take females, and that AA drivers have at least 6 months of sobriety. Joe H reported that the price of gas is going up.
